
Hour For Peace NoCo Memorial for Carol Skylark

When I became the coordinator for the Hour For Peace in August of 2006, she volunteered to help with it and we soon became besties. With her television skills, equipment, and experience, she often filmed and edited the live events, and her production company Light Torch Productions was a sponsor. She sometimes did the program pre-meditations and/or post-meditations. Carol was a peacemaker in thought, word, and deed who gave understanding and unconditional love to all she encountered. She was born Carol Heineman but changed her last name to Skylark. Helen Peak explained, "Skylark symbolizes the divine nature of happiness and joy. 




Carol was well-known for her spiritual healing gifts and her beautiful aura portraits which she created for decades at the Holistic and health Fairs. She even did several of herself.
